Santa Ana District Youth Dodgeball Tournament 2012

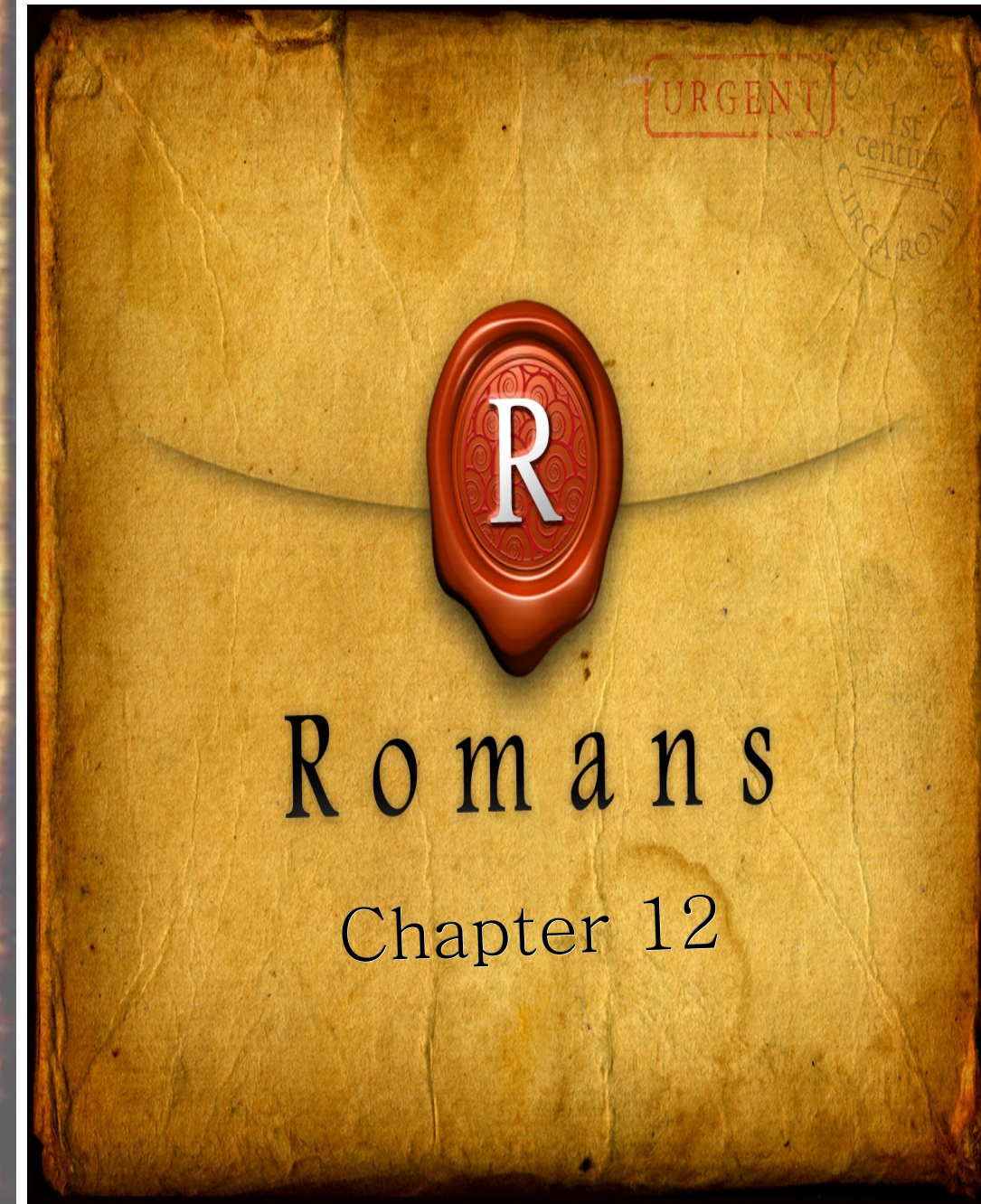
